EMERGENCY SERVICES AT MIDDLE PLAZA

In compliance with San Mateo County's Health Order #c19-5b section 13.f.v., the City of Menlo Park has approved an exemption to Stanford Middle Plaza to conduct emergency work to protect the stability of the site, therefore qualifying as an "emergency condition."

Shoring work on site will take place **Monday – Friday from 8am – 4pm.** This activity will last approximately 6-7 weeks, weather pending.

Concrete pours at the site will be permitted on **Tuesday**, **4/14 and Thursday**, **4/17 from 8am – 6pm**. At least two additional pours will be scheduled on dates yet to be determined.

These activities will proceed with close attention to Occupational Safety and Health Administration and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention guidelines, with specific plans addressing COVID-19 protocols.

Our commitment to the community continues, as we collect community feedback, share information, and mitigate as many impacts as possible to ensure the safety of construction workers and community members.

We encourage all community members to **remain engaged with our communications channels** so we can collaborate and share information.
