

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Cal Water Pipe Relocation

Relocation of the Cal Water pipes, from the middle of the site further to the east, is scheduled throughout March and into early April. Expect moderate noise from large equipment and trucks.

Excavation of the Office Building #2 underground parking garage is anticipated to start in early April. Expect increased noise from large equipment and increased truck traffic on El Camino.

Work on the bioretention area east of the Stanford Park Hotel is anticipated to start in late spring. Expect moderate noise from large equipment and increased truck traffic on El Camino.

West Bay Sanitary Sewer line demolition and installation are anticipated to start in April. Work on El Camino is anticipated to take place at night, per Caltrans requirement. Partial lane closures will be required.

Construction site access is via El Camino at Cambridge Ave.

Roadway flaggers will be on duty as needed to direct trucks and equipment entering and leaving the construction site.

There is noise and dust associated with construction operations. Noise is mitigated as much as possible; however, intermittent noise disruptions can occur. Construction requirements will be met per code. Dust control operations, via water spray, coincide with these operations.

All construction dates are **approximate and subject to change** due to weather and unforeseen conditions.
